PLEASE NOTE TIME & PLACE FOR THE VAKAROS CHECK-IN AND PLEASE INFORM THE PERSON RESPONSIBLE FOR THE UNIT IN YOUR TEAM:

**Each team to check their Vakaros Atlas 2 unit in with Pau Bonet (RC) at the 52 Super Series office container (black one) on Sunday (19 July) from 17.00.**

**Or any other suitable time upon appointment with: [paubonetalcover@gmail.com](mailto:paubonetalcover@gmail.com)**

Check in should take 5 to 10 minutes per unit, the order of check in will be alphabetical, starting with Alegre. If you miss your turn you will have another chance as soon as those on time have been checked in or a gap appears.

Pau will:

- **Check your device has the latest software version.**
- **Check your device in for the regatta.**

Please each team:

- The Atlas 2 User Manual can be found here: <https://support.vakaros.com/>
- Check your device is fully charged. Once so, that should get you through the week if switching it off after use and back on before going out on the water.
- Don't leave the Atlas 2 outdoors when not in use and wipe away salt & salty water with a soft cloth when finished sailing.
- Once your device has been off the bracket and in a poor GPS environment it shall be restarted before racing starts to ensure the best possible GPS performance.
- Calibrate your device by initiating the calibrating mode and moving around the device in a figure 8 pattern till it says calibration completed. If you like Pau will show you how to calibrate your device. --
- Fit the Atlas 2 as the top instrument on your mast instrument bracket AND CONNECT THE SAFETY LINE!
- All devices shall be in position and switched on from leaving port towards the race area.
- Once switched on no need to push any buttons unless you want to. To change screen, press the large button at the bottom of the screen.
