INTRODUCTION

The Puerto Portals 52 Super Series Sailing Week & TP52 20th Anniversary Invitational is organised by the Super Series Eventos Desportivos LDA in collaboration the Club de Regatas Puerto Portals (CRPP) and the TP52 class, collectively the Organizing Authority (OA). The Event Sailing Instructions (ESI) give the 'local' instructions not mentioned in the 2021 NoR/SI and in case of clashes overrules the 2021 NoR/SI or the 2021 Invitational NoR.

1) SCHEDULE OF RACES, INSPECTIONS, CEREMONIES AND BRIEFINGS

- 21 August, Saturday: **Crew Weight Option 1 from 18.00 – 19.00.**
Equipment inspections from 18.00hrs till final day.
- 22 August, Sunday: Registration 10.00 – 12.00
Crew Weight Option 2 from 08.30 – 09.30.
10.00 Skipper's Meeting for Practice Races.
13.00 Practice Starts / Practice Race.
- 23 August, Monday: Registration 10.00 – 12.00,
13.00 **Trophy Practice Race** (combined start 52SS and Invitational, IRC ToT (Time on Time) scoring).
17.00 Skipper's meeting.
Prize giving Trophy Practice Race during the Welcome Cocktail.
- 24 August, Tuesday: 13.00 First warning signal WL Races (separate starts 52SS and Invitational)
- 25 August, Wednesday: 13.00 First warning signal WL Races (separate starts 52SS and Invitational)
- 26 August, Thursday: 13.00 First warning signal WL Races (separate starts 52SS and Invitational)
- 27 August, Friday: **13.00 First warning signal TP52 20th Anniversary WL Races**, the 52Super Series and Invitational boats start together for special (IRC ToT scored) trophies for the combined results of these races (max 2 races).

- 28 August, Saturday: 13.00 First warning signal WL Races (separate starts 52SS and Invitational)

The location for the skipper's meetings: Puerto Portals Sailing Lounge.

2) BERTHING

Please note regatta berthing will be available from mid morning 19 August, Thursday and after the final race boats shall return to their regatta berth and not leave earlier than after the prize giving ceremony, 21.00hrs on 28 August, Saturday. Those arriving earlier please contact the marina for temporary berthing.

3) COURSE AREAS

Races will be sailed in Palma Bay. Approximate position of the course area is:

4) DESCRIPTIONS OF MARKS

Course option 1:

- Marks W, W/o and Gate will be tetrahedron Orange marks.
- Mark W/i will be cylindrical Black and will be removed if there is a change of course involving mark W.
- Starting marks will be race two race committee boats or one race committee boat and a tetrahedron Yellow inflatable buoy.
- Finishing marks will be a race committee boat and a tetrahedron Yellow inflatable buoy.
- New marks as described in NoR/SI 18.1 will be tetrahedron Yellow inflatable buoys.
- Midway gate marks will be tetrahedron Yellow marks.
- For drawings and further course options please see NoR/SI Appendix 1.

5) HAUL-OUT RESTRICTIONS

Boats shall not be hauled out after 20th of August 2021 /18.00h except with and according to the terms of prior written authorisation of the race committee.

6) NoR/SI 8 EVENT MODIFICATIONS (BOW STICKERS DELETED)

As per WS Regulation 20.4 all boats will be required to display:

- Bow numbers (teams may choose to paint these on, pdf templates will be supplied)
- Helmsman (owner drivers may ask to ignore this request) and tactician surnames plus country flag on both sides of the boom.
- Event stickers on both sides of the mast.
- Event stickers on both sides of the boom.
- Event stickers on bowsprit.
- Event stickers in cockpit.
- **Event flag permanently hoisted on the centre aft stanchion (alternative location to be approved by OA).**
- 52 SuperSeries flag to be hoisted when the boats are in dock during the event.

a) **The Trophy Practice Race:**

- 1st Combined Fleet 52 Super Series and TP52 20th Anniversary Invitational

- 1st TP52 20th Anniversary Fleet

b) **The TP52 20th Anniversary WL Day:**

- 1st, 2nd and 3rd prizes for the best scoring three **Owner Driver** boats of the Combined Fleet TP52 20th Anniversary Invitational and 52 Super Series on IRC ToT.

Additional Trophies, only awarded if not doubling up with another 1st place trophy:

- 1st, to the best scoring boat of the **Combined Fleet** on IRC ToT.
- 1st, to the best scoring **TP52 20th Anniversary Invitational** boat.
In addition this boat (if fully compliant with the TP52 Class Rule) is invited to join the **2021 Rolex TP52 World Championship** free of entry fee and class fee.

Please note: The **Owner Driver** trophies are for boats in the results steered by her owner. To qualify for these trophies, the following requirements shall be fulfilled:

- The owner shall provide his/her WS Group 1 certificate at registration time.
- He/She shall be either the owner of the boat or the majority shareholder of the company owning the boat.
- The owner shall be steering his/her boat at all times when racing, except for short breaks for proper reason (like a sanitary stop or for changing clothing) or emergency situations involving the safety of boat or crew (such an incident shall be reported to the race committee, who may protest). The owner shall be at the helm during all mark roundings. NOTE: There is no category restriction on helmsmen releasing the owner from helming.
- The owner may appoint a replacement helmsman to steer when he/she is not on board. This replacement helmsman shall provide his/her WS Group 1 certificate at registration time (Appendix 1 TP52 Bylaws).
- The owner shall helm his boat at least **two** events **including the TP52 World Championship** to qualify for the series owner driver trophy (changes NoR/SI 26.2).

9) COMBINED SCORING SPECIFIC RULES

- 9.1 The Combined Fleet Trophies of the Trophy Practice Race and the TP52 20th Anniversary WL Day will be IRC ToT scored. TP52s competing in the 52 Super Series are not permitted to optimise their rating. **These shall compete under the same IRC TCC: 1.415** (based on a 2021 trial certificate run for a TP52 on / near its class limits).
- 9.2 The TP52s competing in the 52 Super Series racing for the combined trophies shall respect the 52 Super Series NoR/SI and event SI, **except that for these specific races they may use sails not stamped for the 52 Super Series**, on condition that these sails comply with the TP52 Class Rule. Like permitted for their practice racing.
- 9.3 **For the purpose of the TP52 20th Anniversary WL Day's racing the sails carried on board need to remain the same for the duration of that day.** The day begins at the first warning signal of that day and ends when the boat finishes the final race of that day. (Reason: streamlining between the 2 fleets for equal weight and choice)

10) (EXTRA) GUEST TP52 20th ANNIVERSARY WL DAY

- 10.1 In line with NoR/SI 8.7 52 Super Series boats on the TP52 20th Anniversary WL Day may carry a (extra) guest to bring the crew weight in line with that what can be expected to be the average of the Invitational boats. This guest shall:
 - Not bring the total crew weight over **1250** kg.
 - Be on board for all races of the TP52 20th Anniversary WL Day.
 - Be registered at the Race Office by submitting a filled out TP52 20th Anniversary WL Day Guest Form no later than 10.00 on the morning of the TP52 20th Anniversary WL Day.
 - Please note: this specific guest may contribute to the racing of the boat as any crew member.
